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Office of the Grocery Sector Code of Conduct Membership Dues Overview

Membership dues for the Office of the Grocery Sector Code of Conduct are collected annually and are based on a calendar-year cycle. Dues are determined according to each member's annual sales of grocery products in Canada.

The dues structure is as follows:

Sales* Tranche	Annual Membership Dues
More than \$1 billion	\$35,000
More than \$500 million up to \$1 billion	\$20,000
More than \$200 million up to \$500 million	\$7,500
More than \$50 million up to \$200 million	\$3,000
More than \$10 million up to \$50 million	\$500
More than \$50,000 to \$10 million	\$250
Less than \$50,000	\$50

*Sales are defined as 'annual sales of grocery products in Canada'

Note: Membership dues will not be collected before January 1, 2026, and Dispute Resolution Mechanisms will also not be available until that time. Voting rights for members will begin coinciding with the collection of dues.
